### **Photo Contest Rules**

To participate in the KSFGC Photo Contest, you must be a current KSFGC Member. To join or renew your membership, visit [www.ksfgc.org/join-us/](http://www.ksfgc.org/join-us/).

Photo entries should be an obvious illustration of the category in which it is entered. Does the photo tell a story? Most often, the difference between a photo you remember and one that you quickly forget depends on whether the photo tells a story. Photos should be clear and in focus, and the viewer should be able to identify the subject in the photo. Please DO NOT retouch digital photos.

2. Grazing
3. Education

### **Submission Guidelines**

Entrants can submit their color, digital, high-resolution photo files by going to this link: <https://form.jotform.com/200404325339951>, OR by visiting [www.ksfgc.org](http://www.ksfgc.org), and clicking the “KSFGC Photo Contest” tab.

Two submissions per photo class are allowed. The submission link will require you to put your name, email, phone number, KSFGC member number, KS county in which the photo was taken and a title and description of the photo. The contest ends on Friday, October 30, 2020 with all submissions due by 5 p.m.

### **Contest Awards**

Cash prizes will be awarded for the best photos in each photo class.

- \$100 for 1st place
- \$50 for 2nd place
- \$25 for 3rd place

Winners will be announced at the 2020 KSFGC Annual Meeting. Entrants do not need to be present to win, but we encourage your attendance and participation. KSFGC reserves the right to use any photos submitted on our website and social media pages and will credit the photographer when a photo is used. Note: 2nd place will only be awarded in classes with > 5 entries; 3rd place will only be awarded in classes with >10 entries.
